



Post-Hurricane Milton Update #15

Good afternoon,

We have a few more updates to share as we head into the weekend, including the great news that Captiva Drive is now open in both directions, making access easier for everyone. We've also had positive developments in recovery efforts at The Clutch golf course and are pleased to confirm that Provisions and Island Tacos have both reopened as planned.

Roads and Debris Removal:

- The Department of Transportation has completed repairs on Captiva Drive (see picture below). Both lanes are now reopened, allowing two-way traffic.
- Our team will be working from dawn to dusk over the weekend to remove large amounts of sand from the road shoulders so we can also reopen both lanes of South Seas Plantation Road and other resort roads.
- Please drive carefully and stay alert for wildlife on the island.
- Our team made good progress today in clearing debris from the conference center parking lot.

The Clutch Golf Course:

- The golf course pump station is operational, which is a big win for the team. They are now working on repairing pipe breaks throughout the course to restart water flow.
- Sand removal efforts continue on holes 6, 7, 5, and 9b.
- Tree restoration is ongoing, with standing up and staking trees across the course and resort (see pictures below).

The Shops at South Seas Reopenings:

- Provisions and the Island Tacos food truck officially reopened today (see pictures below).
